Main Bible Verse:

(James 1:20) because human anger does not produce the righteousness that God desires.

Summary:

James 1:20 | Jonah 1:2-3

- We must not do things by flesh and blood, but we must change it to our obedience to the Lord.
- Our anger and flesh and blood cannot turn into the righteous life that God desires.
 - Anger is of our fleshly desire, so we must put our will, flesh, and emotions.
 - Once we put these down and depart from our anger, we must enter into the life of praise for this is what God wants us to do.
- It is because of our human will that we will encounter problems.
- When the flesh and blood, human will, and emotion comes to us, we must kneel down, prepare our hearts, and pray to God to ask Him for help.
- If we can overcome our human will, God will definitely answer our prayers.
 - o He is our Lord, and He will help us.
- What we need is the direction from God.
- God wanted Jonah to go to Ninevah.
 - Jonah deliberately opposed God's direction for him.
- We must not have anger in us for God's righteousness will leave us.
 - o Instead, we must have praise upon praise until God opens the gate for us.
- Our failure comes from going against God's direction for us.

John 14:6 | Psalms 103:19 | 1 Corinthians 9:26-27 | Acts 16:25-26 | 1 Corinthians 14:1-2

- Jesus said that He is our way, truth, and life.
 - The way is our direction.
 - If our direction is wrong, everything will go wrong.
 - Our success has greatly to do with our direction.
 - The truth is the method for our direction.
 - o When we follow God's method and direction for us, we will have life.
- We are all administered by God.
- Paul especially taught us that we must have the direction from God for when it is lost, everything will go astray.
 - God's direction for us is always correct.
- The key of the kingdom of heaven is at church, and without it we cannot do anything.
 - O What is the key of the kingdom of heaven?
 - It is praise upon praise.
 - o Paul and Silas praised throughout the night while they were in jail.
 - Their praise could bring miracles because they followed God's direction.
- When we do not know how to pray, we must pray in tongues.
 - o Paul taught us that it is important to pray in tongues for that is when God will give us our direction.
 - When we do so, God will give us mysteries.

- No matter what comes up in our lives, we must not worry or fear because God is with us and will help us.
 - o How much faith we have is how much we will receive.
 - o Therefore, we must not doubt but have full faith in God.

Matthew 11:28 | Romans 10:13-14

- No matter what burdens we have we must bring them before God.
 - He will help us with everything, but we must be willing to come before Him and pass our worries and burdens to Him.
- For, "Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved."
 - o This salvation is of the spirit, soul, and body.
 - We will receive salvation in every aspect of our lives.
- We must pray at least 5 minutes in the morning and 5 minutes in the evening.
