Summary:

John 10:10

- It must not be by our own feelings that we do things but with the direction from God that we must do everything.
- There is a mystery connecting the church and Christ.
 - The church was born from Christ, so we can come to church to receive our direction.
 - We must ask until God tells us what to do.
- The thief may come to steal, kill, and destroy when we are careless, but if we walk out from ourselves to pray, Jesus will give us His life.

- 3 important points
 - Call in the name of the Lord and we will be saved.
 - We must believe until we hear God speak to us.
 - We must hear God in order to be sent.
- We must ask Jesus and wait for His answer for us.
 - Without His answer, we must not do anything.
 - Without God's instruction we must not dare to do anything.
- How can we be strong in God's power?
 - We must put on the full armor of God, and we will be able to stand against the devil's scheme.
 - We do not know when dangers will come, so we must always be prepared.
 - The devil will take the opportunity when we do not pray, read the Bible, and praise to attack us.
- God loves to hear our prayers and praise.

- We must come to church with an empty heart, but when we meet God, we will receive His mysteries.
 - We must come to church to pray and praise, and we will grow our man in Christ.
- When we speak in tongues, we will be able to silence the foes and avengers.
- We must never stop coming to church, speaking in tongues, praising God, and following Him.
 - When we do this, we will mature our man in Christ within us.
