- After the death of Moses the servant of the Lord, the Lord said to Joshua son of Nun, Moses' aide: "Moses my servant is dead. Now then, you and all these people, get ready to cross the Jordan River into the land I am about to give to them—to the Israelites.
- God's three promise to Joshua:
 - 1. v(Joshua 1:3) I will give you every place where you set your foot, as I promised Moses.
 - 2. v(Joshua 1:4) Your territory will extend from the desert to Lebanon, and from the great river, the Euphrates—all the Hittite country—to the Mediterranean Sea in the west.
 - 3. v(Joshua 1:5) No one will be able to stand against you all the days of your life. As I was with Moses, so I will be with you; I will never leave you nor forsake you.
- Three times God encouraged Joshua:
 - 1. v(Joshua 1:6) Be strong and courageous, because you will lead these people to inherit the land I swore to their ancestors to give them.
 - 2. v(Joshua 1:7) "Be strong and very courageous. Be careful to obey all the law my servant Moses gave you; do not turn from it to the right or to the left, that you may be successful wherever you go.
 - **3.** v(Joshua 1:9) Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged, for the Lord your God will be with you wherever you go."

Matthew 1:21-23

- God with us is the promise God bestow on all who believe in His salvation.
 - o v(Matthew 1:21-23) ²¹ She will give birth to a son, and you are to give him the name Jesus, because he will save his people from their sins." ²² All this took place to fulfill what the Lord had said through the prophet: ²³ "The virgin will conceive and give birth to a son, and they will call him Immanuel" (Immanuel means "God with us").
 - o God with us is the will of God.
 - Jesus is Immanuel.
 - Immanuel = God with us.
 - o God delivered us from sin and promised to be with us.
 - When God is with us.
 - The resurrection power is on us.
 - We will overcome and have victory in all aspect of our lives.
 - This is our key to overcome, to be successful, and to have a beautiful family.

- God's three principle to Joshua:
 - 2. Be careful to obey all the law my servant Moses gave you. (Joshua 1:7)
 - o v(Deuteronomy 31:7-8) ⁷ Then Moses summoned Joshua and said to him in the presence of all Israel, "Be strong and courageous, for you must go with this people into the land that the Lord swore to their ancestors to give them, and you must divide it among them as their inheritance. ⁸ The Lord himself goes before you and will be with you; he will never leave you nor forsake you. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged."
 - v(Deuteronomy 31:23) The Lord gave this command to Joshua son of Nun: "Be strong and courageous, for you will bring the Israelites into the land I promised them on oath, and I myself will be with you."
 - When Joshua obeyed all the laws God's servant Moses gave him (God's word):
 - Joshua had victory in the battle of Jericho.
 - Joshua led the Israelites enter the promise land.
 - v(Joshua 4:14) That day the Lord exalted Joshua in the sight of all Israel; and they stood in awe of him all the days of his life, just as they had stood in awe of Moses.
 - v(Joshua 6:27) So the Lord was with Joshua, and his fame spread throughout the land.
 - When Joshua failed to follow God's command:
 - Joshua lost the battle of Ai. (Ai is a very small town with very few people.)
 - When Joshua repented and returned:
 - v(Joshua 8:1) Then the Lord said to Joshua, "Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged. Take the whole army with you, and go up and attack Ai. For I have delivered into your hands the king of Ai, his people, his city and his land.
 - 2. Do not turn from it to the right or to the left, that you may be successful wherever you go. (Joshua 1:7)
 - God's word is absolute.
 - There is no grey area in God's word.

- We must follow God's word 100%.
- In all our ways, acknowledge God's word.
- God's word is His promise.
- v(Proverbs 3:5-6) Trust in the LORD with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways acknowledge him, and he will make your paths straight.
- o When Adam and Eve failed to keep God's command, they lost their eternal life.
 - v(Genesis 2:16-17) ¹⁶ And the Lord God commanded the man, "You are free to eat from any tree in the garden; ¹⁷ but you must not eat from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, for when you eat from it you will certainly die."
- How did Adam and Eve failed to keep God's command?
 - They listened to the snake (satan) and trusted what they see with their own eyes and doubted God's word.
 - v(Genesis 3:4) "You will not certainly die," the serpent said to the woman. 5 "For God knows that when you eat from it your eyes will be opened, and you will be like God, knowing good and evil."
 - v(Genesis 3:6) When the woman saw that the fruit of the tree was good for food and pleasing to the eye, and also desirable for gaining wisdom, she took some and ate it. She also gave some to her husband, who was with her, and he ate it.
 - When they ate from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, the glory of God left them.
- o Do not eat from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil.
 - Paul's prayer to the church of Philippi: Do not take the fruit of the knowledge of good and evil. Do not depart from God's word.
 - v(Philippians 1:9-11) ⁹ And this is my prayer: that your love may abound more and more in knowledge and depth of insight, ¹⁰ so that you may be able to discern what is best and may be pure and blameless for the day of Christ, ¹¹ filled with the fruit of righteousness that comes through Jesus Christ--to the glory and praise of God.
- 3. v(Joshua 1:8) Keep this Book of the Law always on your lips; meditate on it day and night, so that you may be careful to do everything written in it. Then you will be prosperous and successful.
 - o v(Proverbs 4:23) Above all else, guard your heart, for everything you do flows from it.
 - o v(Proverbs 4:24) Keep your mouth free of perversity; keep corrupt talk far from your lips.
 - o v(Proverbs 4:25) Let your eyes look straight ahead; fix your gaze directly before you.
 - o v(Proverbs 4:26) Give careful thought to the paths for your feet and be steadfast in all your ways.
 - o v(Proverbs 4:27) Do not turn to the right or the left; keep your foot from evil.

1 Corinthians 10:5

- The three principles God gave Joshua is the key to live a life that is a pleasing to the Lord.
 - o Keep God's command. Obey them 100%.
 - Keep our tongue from evil and our lips from telling lies.
 - Turn from evil and do good; seek peace and pursue it.
 - Only Caleb and Joshua were able to enter the land of God's promise.
 - Caleb: Followed God wholeheartedly.
