- Do not worry!
 - o All things are possible through Christ who strengthens us.
 - Do not worry about our lives, do not worry about our food, do not worry about our food, for God will create for us.
 - Worry is a sin.
 - God does not want us to worry.
 - Worry is against the command of God.
 - Worry is against the apostles' teaching.
- v(Philippians 4:6) Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God.
 - Being anxious is not good for our health.
- v(1 Peter 5:7) Cast all your anxiety on him because he cares for you.
 - o God loves us, He cares for us, and He knows what is the best for us.
 - We must trust in Him.

- o God is always watching over us, protecting us, and providing for us.
 - We will lack nothing.
- o If we trust God, we will not be anxious.
 - Do not worry. Do not be afraid.
- If we fully trust God, we will trust all His method.
 - No matter what we are experiencing or how other people are treating us, we trust God that everything is benefiting us.
 - Do not doubt God's timing or His method.
 - God is our heavenly Father.

<u>Isaiah 49:15 | John 6:27 | Matthew 6:33 | 1 Samuel 2:30 | Matthew 4:4</u>

- v(Isaiah 49:15) "Can a mother forget the baby at her breast and have no compassion on the child she has borne? Though she may forget, I will not forget you!
 - o God will never forget us, nor forsake us.
 - o God is good to us all the time for His love endures forever.
 - o For His glory, He will watch over us.
- v(John 6:27) Do not work for food that spoils, but for food that endures to eternal life, which the Son of Man will give you. On him God the Father has placed his seal of approval."
 - Do not let our heart go astray and focus on the worldly things.
 - For the pagans run after all these things.
 - Our heavenly Father knows that We need them.
 - God will give us food that endures to eternal life.
- v(Matthew 6:33) But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well.
 - o First seek His kingdom and His righteousness.
 - o All these things will be added unto you.
 - o First seek His kingdom and His righteousness is the key to not worry.
 - Put God's work as our top priority.
 - Do not focus on our own need.
 - Those who honors God He will honor.
 - We do not live on bread alone, but on every word that comes from the mouth of God.
- v(1 Samuel 2:30) "Therefore the LORD, the God of Israel, declares: 'I promised that your house and your father's house would minister before me forever.' But now the LORD declares: 'Far be it from me! Those who honor me I will honor, but those who despise me will be disdained.
- v(Matthew 4:4) Jesus answered, "It is written: 'Man does not live on bread alone, but on every word that comes from the mouth of God.'"

1 Thessalonians 4:11 | 2 Thessalonians 3:10

- v(1 Thessalonians 4:11)Make it your ambition to lead a quiet life, to mind your own business and to work with your hands, just as we told you,
- v(2 Thessalonians 3:10-12) ¹⁰ For even when we were with you, we gave you this rule: "The one who is unwilling to work shall not eat." ¹¹ We hear that some among you are idle and disruptive. They are not busy;

they are busybodies. ¹² Such people we command and urge in the Lord Jesus Christ to settle down and earn the food they eat.

- Do not worry does not mean to be lazy and not to do anything.
- o Paul especially reminded us to mind our own business and to work with our hands.
 - "The one who is unwilling to work shall not eat."
- Put God's work as our top priority.
 - Put our hearts where God's work is and first seek His righteousness.
 - Be about God's house.
 - Do not fix our eyes on worldly needs and be wearied and burdened.
 - Be one who's a pleasing in God's eyes and He will provide for us.

Genesis 22:1-18 | I Kings 3

- When Abraham put God as his top priority and followed God's command.
 - When he brought his son Isaac before God as a sacrifice, God not only did not take his son away from him, Abraham and his son Isaac were both able to experience God's wonder and receive God's promise.
- Solomon first sought God's wisdom.
 - Solomon sought God's wisdom to help God's people.
 - Solomon did not seek God's wisdom to his own honor.
- Solomon's prayer was a pleasing to the Lord.
 - God blessed Solomon with a wise and discerning heart, so that there has never been anyone like
 Solomon, nor will there ever be.
 - o God blessed Solomon with all the riches and honor.
 - o In Solomon's lifetime, he had no equal among kings.
- These are all examples showing us, how when we first seek God's kingdom and His righteousness, everything else will be added unto us.

Psalms 33:9 | Matthew 6:34 | 2 Corinthians 12:9

- v(Psalms 33:9) For he spoke, and it came to be; he commanded, and it stood firm.
 - God's word is righteous and just.
 - We must honor God's word.
 - When we honor God, He will honor us.
- v(Matthew 6:34) Therefore do not worry about tomorrow, for tomorrow will worry about itself. Each day has enough trouble of its own.
 - Do not worry about tomorrow.
 - o Simply focus on our current task and fulfill our responsibilities for this day.
 - o Leave all things beyond this day in God's hand.
 - o God's daily grace and strength for us is more than sufficient for all the troubles for our day.
- v(2 Corinthians 12:9) But he said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness." Therefore I will boast all the more gladly about my weaknesses, so that Christ's power may rest on me.
 - o God's grace is sufficient for us.

- o God's power is made perfect in our weakness.
- o This is how we should proclaim when we are struggling to overcome.
 - Proclaim until the power of God falls upon us.
 - Proclaim until we receive faith from God.
 - Proclaim until all our weariness, discouragement, and un-believe depart from us.
- o Boast about our weakness and let Christ's power rest on us.
 - Do not worry about tomorrow.
 - Do not try to pick up tomorrow's trouble.
 - Proclaim God's grace and His power and let God lead us into victory.

<u>Isaiah 43:19 | Matthew 11:28 | Psalms 8:4 | Proverbs 3:5-8 | Psalms 1:3</u>

- v(Isaiah 43:19) See, I am doing a new thing! Now it springs up; do you not perceive it? I am making a way in the desert and streams in the wasteland.
 - Trust in the Lord.
 - God will open a new and living way for us.
- v(Matthew 11:28) "Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest.
 - o God is mindful of us and He cares for us.
 - Come before God.
 - Hand all our troubles and burdens over to God.
 - Receive God's rest.
 - Prioritize God's kingdom commission.
 - Do only what God want us to do.
 - Leave all the rest to God.
 - In all our ways, acknowledge Him.
 - God will make whatever we do prosper.
 - This is a life that glorifies the Lord.
