Psalms 33:6-14

- Sunday is the day to honor our Lord.
 - We come to church to worship and love our Lord.
- If we read Psalms 33 multiple times and understand it, our view and our heart will be changed.
- Psalms 33 tells us about the kingdom.
 - o In these last days, we must grab on to Jesus and His kingdom.
- One very important verse from Psalms 33 is verse 9.
 - o For he spoke, and it came to be; he commanded, and it stood firm. (Psalms 33:9)
- If we follow God's plan, then our success comes from the Lord.
 - If we follow our own plans, our failure comes from ourselves.
- When God made Adam, He breathed the breath of life onto Adam.
 - o This is why we come to church to lift up our hands to receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.

- We must ask the Lord to fill us with His Holy Spirit when we worship.
- When God commands and speaks, it is created.
- Our success and failure depend on the Lord's command.
 - We must come to church only for the Lord.
 - We must have Jesus' direction in us.

 - o Therefore, when we choose God as our Lord, He will choose us for His inheritance.
- As a Christian, we must have a grateful heart when we come to church.
 - o When we come to church, we receive the kingdom in our hearts.
- We must read the bible and lift up our hands at home.
- Everything we do should be for Jesus because our hearts are for the kingdom.
- In verse 13 it says the Lord is looks down from heaven.
 - o From heaven the Lord looks down and sees all mankind (Psalms 33:19)
 - o God is looking at His chosen people and observing them.
 - Are we reading the bible?
 - Are we running to church for Jesus?
- When we have the keys of the kingdom of heaven, God will open the door for us.
 - We must make up our mind to seek and endeavor for the kingdom.
- If we come to church for the kingdom and Jesus, our prayers will be answered, and we will prosper.
 - o If we come for others or our own selfish gain, it will be very difficult for our prayers to be answered.
- When we continue to endeavor and read the bible, and we will receive blessings from God.
 - When we run continuously yet we gain nothing, we must change our mindset and ensure that we are coming to church for the right reason.
- Every week when we come to church, we fill ourselves up with the truth from the bible. We take the bible verse every week and we pray and worship.
 - When we let our faith grow we can receive wisdom from God.
- When we come to church for the right reason, we will:
 - o Receive the strength from the Lord.
 - Our prayers will prosper.

Psalms 63:2-4 | John 14:6

- David was a man after God's heart.
 - He knew how to receive the power from God.
 - David saw the power and glory of God.
 - o I have seen you in the sanctuary and beheld your power and your glory. (Psalms 63:2)

- We must come to church to lift up our hands and worship to be filled with the power of the Holy Spirit.
 - When we come to church for Jesus, we will be filled.

 - Do not let your hearts be troubled. You believe in God; believe also in me. (John 14:1)
- We get into trouble because we follow our own heads to do things.
 - We must worship in Spirit and in Truth to do things.
- The things we have to do are decided by the Lord.
 - o The success of the Samaritan woman came from worshipping in Spirit and in truth.
- Jesus loves us.
 - He wants to become our way and truth so that we can have this abundant life.
- Everything is made by God.
 - In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was with God in the beginning. Through him all things were made; without him nothing was made that has been made. (John 1:1-3)
 - Our success in our work, today's happenings, and our future comes from allowing the Lord to create for
 us because everything was made by Him.
